Home Learning Expectations

- Two pieces of home learning every week, either Maths or English and then a spelling homework. This will be handed out on a Thursday and is expected to be handed in the following Tuesday.
- A spelling test will on a Thursday. Spellings will be learnt on 'spelling shed'
 - Reading every day!

What will we be learning?

Our topics this year are:

- Is it Right to Fight? We will be looking at World War II (Autumn Term).
- Up Pompeii, where we will be looking at the Romans and some natural disasters such as volcanos (Spring Term).
- Tomb raiders, where we will be looking at the Egyptians (Summer Term).

So what's new?

- Recorders Unfortunately, children will not be learning recorders, at the start of this year due to Covid. However, our Music teacher will still be teaching our music lesson each Wednesday.
- Flurrish For 15 minutes everyday children will use an iPad to practise their timetables. Every Friday, using the app, the children will be tested on these.
- No afternoon playtime and during morning break, snack is not provided. Children are allowed to bring in a **healthy snack** such as fruit or a cereal bar (no nuts).

So what's new? Merits!

Children are awarded merits for:

- Good behaviour
- Reading 7x a week (This needs to be signed by an adult in the reading record. Seven signatures gets the merit).
- ▶ 9 or 10/10 on the spelling test.
- 25 merits= bronze
- ▶ 50 merits = silver
- ▶ 100 merits = gold
- ▶ 150 merits = diamond
