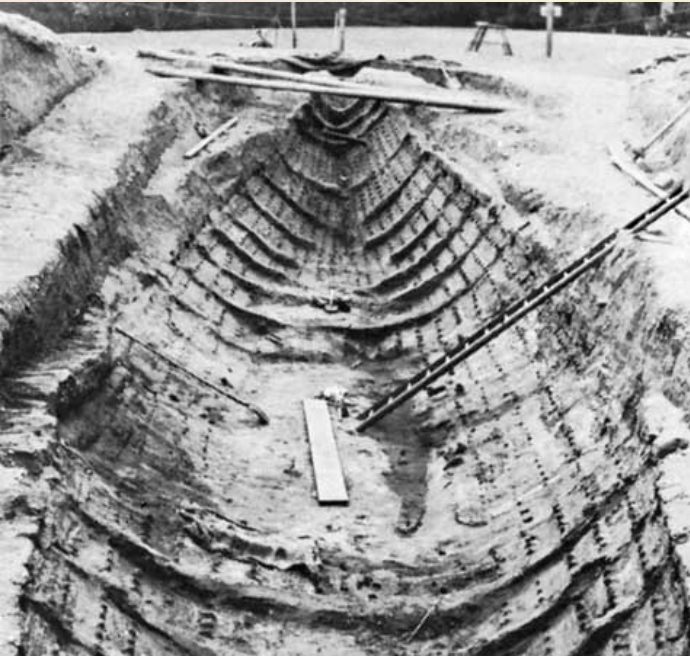


# Sutton Hoo facts
