<p>Make a pretend fish tank out of a cardboard box.</p> <p>You can make the plants and fish to go in your box. Be creative with how you make your fish. You could use paper, sweet wrappers, foil from Easter eggs or anything else that you can find.</p>	<p>Make a boat.</p> <p>You could use empty containers, paper or any other objects that you could find. It would be even more amazing if you could make a boat that really floats.</p>	<p>Decorate a stone or shell.</p> <p>This might be one that you already have at home or you could find a stone from outside and use this. You could use paint or anything else that you have at home.</p>	<p>Find out about the fish from 'Finding Nemo'</p> <p>What kind of fish are Nemo and Dory? What can you find out about these types of fish? Make a factfile.</p>
<p>Design and make your own beach hut.</p> <p>What colour will it be? What could you make this out of? What things could you make to go in your beach hut?</p>	<p>Make your own seagull.</p> <p>You could use card, a paper plate, an old sock or any combination of these. There are loads of ideas on the internet if you need a bit of Inspiration.</p>	<p>Invent a pirate.</p> <p>Make up your own pirate character. Draw a picture showing what they look like. What do they wear? What's their ship called? Do they have any interesting pirate features? (e.g. eyepatch, hook, hat, parrot)</p>	<p>Design the ultimate sandcastle.</p> <p>If you have any sand at home, then you could even make it. If you don't then draw a picture of it, create a collage or make it using plasticine/play-doh.</p>
<p>Look under a stone.</p> <p>Draw or photograph what you can see.</p>	<p>Write a seaside song.</p> <p>Write your own lyrics (words) and make up the tune. You can then use objects around your house as instruments so that you can play and sing your song to your family.</p>	<p>Invent a Game.</p> <p>Make up your own game that you could play on the beach and that you can also play at home.
