

## Welcome to Online Learning in EYFS

As we move back to remote learning, we will be using the platform that we all should be familiar with and have login details to, Tapestry!

This platform allows us the opportunity to post challenges, tasks and videos for the children to interact with at home, but also allows you opportunity to share with us your children's learning by posting photos and videos of what they have done. Your child's class teacher will then have the opportunity to comment and like these posts to provide you with feedback.

We are expecting all children in Early Years to begin using the system on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> January. From this date, teachers will be setting tasks to cover the weeks topic over a variety of learning areas, these are expected to be completed (and where appropriate submitted) on that day. Please keep an eye out on Tapestry for a video from your child's class teacher to explain the structure of the tasks in more detail.

We will rely upon you to ensure the children are provided with the daily access to the teaching resources and activities as well as opportunities to submit assignments and maintain communication with us.
