As part of our Values Based Education initiative, during the month of November we shall be studying the value of Peace.

The value of Peace connects with many other values including Love, Compassion, Respect, Responsibility, Tolerance and Friendship – and many more. The children will be encouraged to think about Peace, starting with peace in their own lives. Peace with their family, their friends, with others around them.
