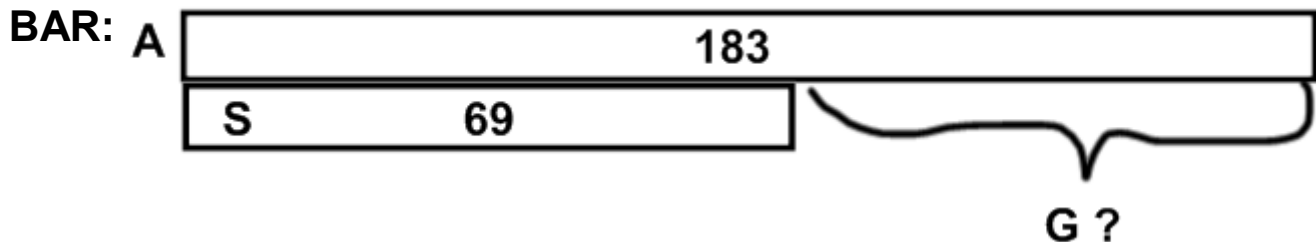


# Subtraction

Remember when you subtract (take away) a number from another you should end up with a number worth LESS.

The farmer had 183 animals. 69 sheep the rest of them were goats.  
How many goats did he have?



Number sentence:  $G = 183 - 69$
