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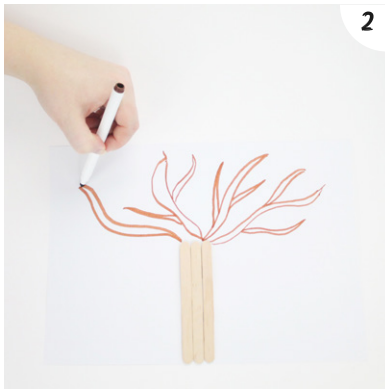
Dried Petal Pictures

Supplies

- Selection of dried petals
- A4 white or blue card
- Brown felt tip pen
- PVA glue
- Lolly sticks



- 1 Create a trunk for the tree by gluing three lolly sticks to the centre of the card.



- 2 Using the brown felt tip, draw branches for the blossom to hang from.



- 3 Glue flower petals onto the drawn branches, then leave to dry.

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
