When joining Tudor School, every pupil had to agree to an 'Acceptable use and e-safety agreement' which is outlined on the school website. - I will not give out my own/others details such as name, phone number, home address or social media. Google classroom is a learning tool not a social media platform.
- I will be responsible for my behaviour when using ICT because I know that these rules are to keep me safe
- I will support the school approach to online safety and not upload or add any images, video, sounds or text that could upset any member of the school community
- I know that my use of ICT can be checked and my parent/carer will be contacted if a member of school staff is concerned about my safety or my online behavior
