## Reading

Reading daily at home is incredibly important, particularly at this age. Each child will be given a reading book based on their needs.

We will be assessing the children's reading skills regularly. The key thing is to ensure that the children can read with a high degree of fluency and also with a good understanding of what they've read. Books will not be changed every day as the children will need the opportunity to fully explore their content. There will be several opportunities for changing books every week.

#### **Weekly Home Learning**
