



Uniform


Uniform expectations remain the same as last year. New uniform can be purchased from the school office.

- ▶ Seaside Rescue(Summer Term)



Reading

Reading daily at home is incredibly important, particularly at this age. Each child will be given a reading book every week based on the focus in phonics.
