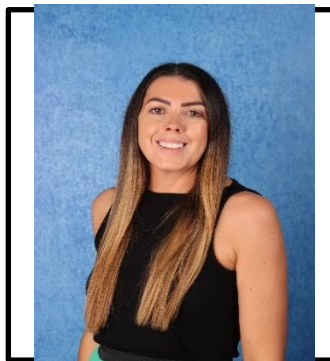

GETTING TO KNOW YOU AND YOUR CHILD

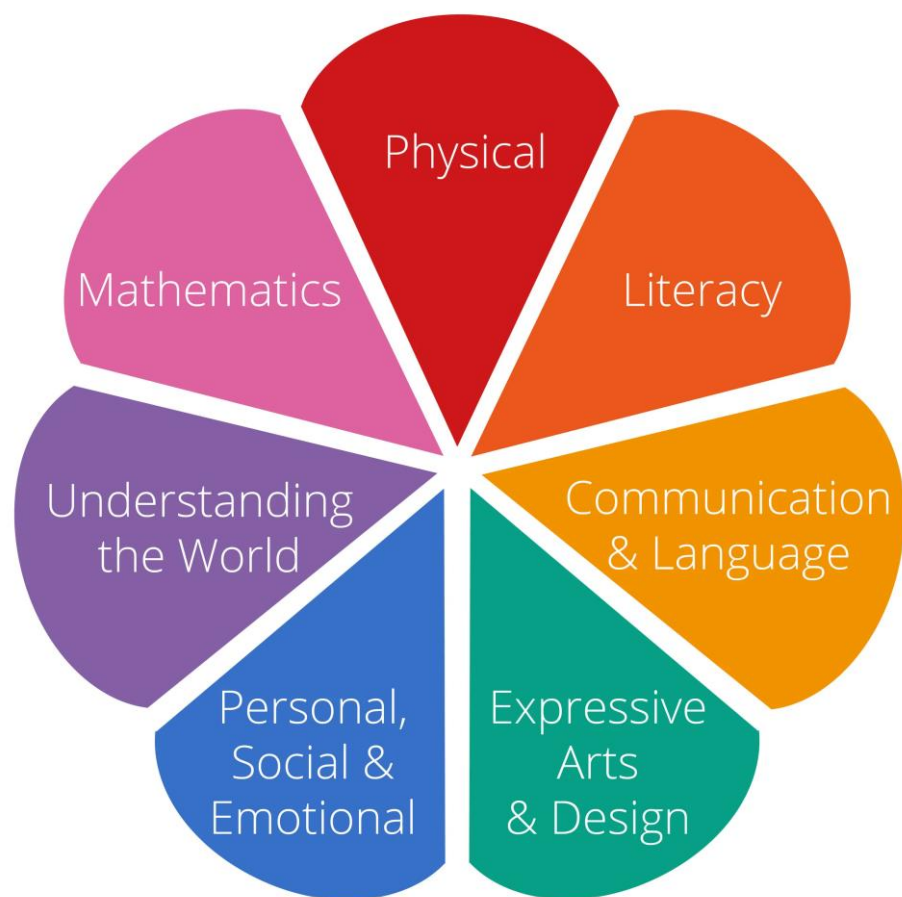


We will do this by:

Tudor P.E kit can be purchased from our school office.



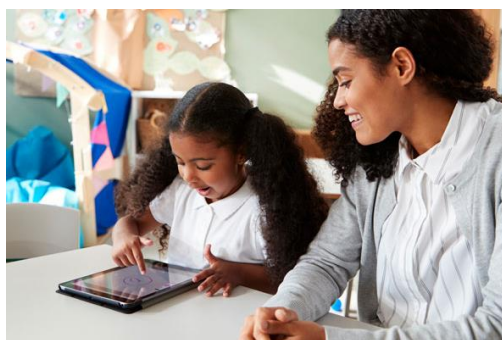

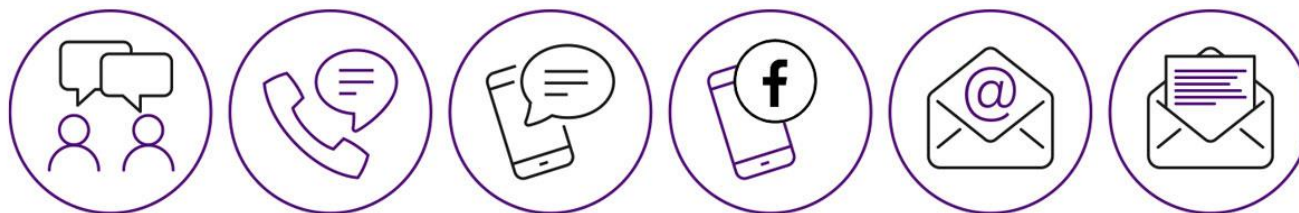


Communication is so important. It plays a huge role in ensuring that you are regularly sharing information with us to best support your child.

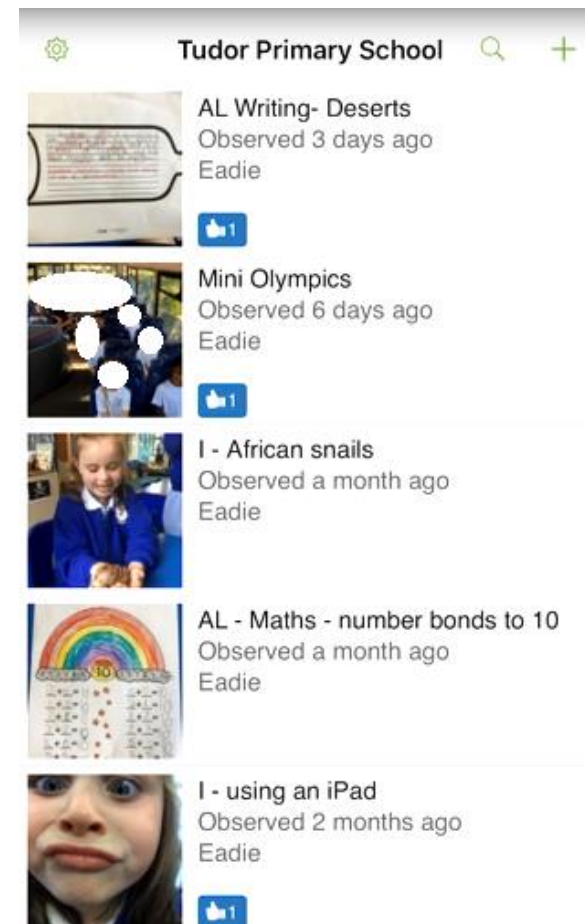

TAPESTRY ONLINE LEARNING JOURNAL



- Once you have provided your email address, you will be sent an email to set up your own tapestry account. You can access tapestry on most smart devices, tablets and computers.
- You will then be able to access your child's learning observations where you can explore what they have been doing at school.
- The observations will be based on a variety of topics and a mix of child initiated activities and adult led inputs.
- Tapestry allows you to comment on your child's observations but also upload your own if you would like to share something your child has learnt at home.

SUPPORT FOR YOUR CHILD



WHAT WILL YOUR CHILD NEED AT SCHOOL?



- Suitable clothing e.g. coat, sun hat etc.
- A book bag: this should have your child's home/school diary and reading book and record in daily.
- A named water bottle
- A change of clothes: in case of accidents, including underwear, to be kept on their peg in a named carrier or draw string bag. PLEASE DO NOT PUT THIS IN A BACKPACK.
- Please make sure EVERY item of clothing is named, even shoes!
- For reception children, a healthy lunch in a named lunchbox, if your child is not having school dinners. (Please note, that no nuts or products that may contain nuts can come into school)
- It is optional if your child wants to bring in their own wellies for muddier days, however we offer a range of sizes.

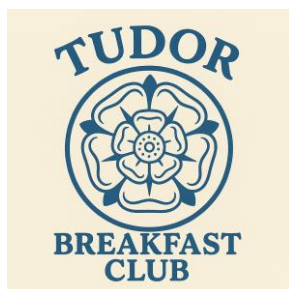
BREAKFAST CLUB
