Year 4 Expectations

- ▶ Red Home/School link books need to be handed in everyday so that key messages or homework can be passed on efficiently. If you have any questions please write in the book and the class teacher will get back to you.
- ▶ Colour banded books and reading records to be handed in everyday. Please read with your child every night and sign their reading record as it is really important for their learning. Reading books must be present in school each day.
- ▶ Attendance - Please ensure your child is in everyday as we work in sequences.
- ▶ P.E. days - Monday and Wednesday's are our allocated PE days. Please make sure your child has their PE kit in on these days.
- ▶ Swimming - This will take place in the summer term. They will need a swimming costume or trunks, swimming hat and towel. Goggles are to your preference.
- ▶ Packed lunches - Please ensure that is a healthy packed lunch and nut free. Healthy snacks (fruit or vegetables) are allowed during morning break.
